While we were encouraged in June and early July by our state's vaccination rate and low number of COVID cases, we have unfortunately seen a recent spike in cases at a concerning pace. The CDC has recently updated and revised its recommendations on wearing masks indoors to once again state that everyone over the age of 2 should wear masks while inside. Therefore in the best interest of keeping our students, faculty and community as safe as possible, we will once again require our PS and PK students to wear masks while indoors. KINDER-GRADE 8 STUDENTS

Please form two drive-thru lanes in the morning. Pastor Becker & Mr. Klemp will help your child to the lanai from your car.

In the afternoon, please form three lanes. Teachers will walk your child to your car; please stay in your car. Remember to display your name card on your visor or dashboard. If picking up multiple children, come at the later pick up time.

K-4: 220-230pm (120-130pm on Wednesdays)

PS-PK, 5-8: 230-240pm (130-140pm on Wednesdays)

# **OUT-OF-STATE TRAVEL POLICY UPDATE**

If anyone within your household or out of state visitors are residing in your household, please review our Out-Of-State Travel Policy below. Thank you for your support!

Per our COVID19 Handbook:

<u>Home to School Communication:</u> Trinity Lutheran School requires that parents inform the Office Manager immediately if any of the following occur:

- Student or household member travels outside of the state
  - Any household that has a visitor staying with the family that has arrived from out of state
    - (Please provide a negative COVID test or Vaccination Card from all guests)
- 2. Student or household member tests positive for COVID-19
- 3. Student or household member is in close contact (6 feet for more than 10 minutes) with an individual that tested positive for COVID-19

Fully vaccinated students/staff will not have to quarantine (Vaccination card needs to be on file in the school office). Teachers will do their best to continue education via online learning until they are cleared by the HDOH.
